\* Each team or freestyle performer, whose official registration duly reaches the Organiser of the competition before its official deadline, will have the opportunity, under the terms and conditions set by the Organiser, to book a maximum of fifteen (15) minutes of training time between 8:00 and 24:00 pm (local time of the competition) to be performed within forty-eight (48) hours prior to Official Speed Setting Flights. The team must book this time with the Organiser before the official registration deadline. After the deadline the Organiser may offer the remaining time to anyone. Junior performers have priority between 08:00 and 18:00.

#### Deadline registration:

Please note that the deadline for Final Registration was March 1. The late registration deadline was March 7.

#### Book your training time:

If you wish to book training time during the official training period (March 21 – April 3) you need to do it now as we are almost fully booked. Before the deadline for Final Registration (March 1) a maximum of 30 minutes of training time per team per day could be booked from March 28, 10 days prior to the start of the event. On the pre competition training days (April 4 and 5) each team or freestyle performer could only book a maximum of fifteen (15) minutes of training on either the 4th OR 5th of April.

Note: After the Late Registration deadline (March 7th), if we have availability, we will allow for each team to book another 30 minutes of training time per day and also another 15 minutes on either the 4th OR the 5th of April. ### 4. Transportation

Judges and competition staff that need transportation on arrival between Brussels Airports (BRU, CRL) or Charleroi Sud train station and the Official Hotel for the competition (Van Der Valk - Hotel Charleroi Airport) must make a request using the following link : <https://forms.gle/XfZ3ftLJSUxLzwB37>. The deadline for requesting a transport is March 20. The shuttle is only available for Judges and competition staff.

We recommend hiring a rental car for this event. This will give you freedom to move to and from Airspace Indoor Skydiving during competition hours as well as flexibility to enjoy your time off.

## **6. Food**

### **Music files:**

Freestyle and Dynamic 2-way teams will receive an instruction email regarding how to upload their music files.

Filename should be event.country.teamname (Events: FreeS-Open, Free-S-Junior and D2W).

Example: FreeS-Open.Norway.HåvardFlaat

The music file must be exactly as needed for the performance. 3 short beeps followed by one long beep will automatically be added to each file to serve as a countdown to the athletes, judges and audience. You should therefore not add one yourself.

### **Procedure:**

When you receive an instruction email from the ISC please click on the link. You will be asked to log in or sign up. Please use the email you used for your ClicknClear licenses if you licensed your music through ClicknClear. Once logged in, you will be asked to upload your music. Please upload a maximum file length of 1 minute 45 seconds in .mp3 or .wav format. If you are using music that is in the Public Domain, you will need to confirm this on the system and accept that you are liable

for any misinformation you have provided to us. Once music has been uploaded, the system will recognise the music being used and check if there is a license for it. If your music is licensed, you do not need to do anything further. If your music is not licensed, you may be able to license the music via ClicknClear. Please click 'License Missing Tracks'. If you licensed your music but did not do so via ClicknClear, you can submit your license agreement PDF on the same page as the audio uploader. If the music has not been identified please contact [support@clicknclear.com](mailto:support@clicknclear.com). All competitors wishing to perform with music must bring their own music headsets.


Freestyle rules:

- 5.2.1.3 Performers must deliver a video (static view, without music) of their Free Routine(s) to the Chief Judge at least seventy-two (72) hours before the start of the competition, and access provided to all Judges. (Performers may optionally include a written list of elements and/or present and explain their Free Routine(s) to the panel.) Each Performer may submit multiple Free Routines, but during the competition, may submit a change only one time. Teams must declare which Free Routine they will perform for each Free Round.
- 2.8 Working Time: The period of time during which a Performer may perform a routine during a Flight. Working time starts the instant the Performer begins flying, as determined by the Judges.
- Compulsory Routine: Working Time is 45 seconds.
  - Free Routine: Working Time is minimum 75 to a maximum of 90 seconds.
- Each Performer must declare the length of his/her Free Routine before the competition begins. Music duration must not be longer than 10 seconds over the routine's time

Dynamic:

- 5.2.2 Teams must deliver a video of their Free Routine(s) to the Chief Judge at least two (2) days in advance (48 hours) before the start of the competition. The video must be uploaded to the designated ISC Cloud or as is described in Bulletin 2. Competitors are responsible for the quality of the video delivered. The quality should be at least that described in para. 4.2.8. for a satisfactory scoring of Technical Difficulty by Judges.
- 5.2.3 Failure to provide the video of the Free Routine(s) within the time limit stated in para. 5.2.2 will lead to receiving no credit for Technical Difficulty for all Free Routines.

The Opening Ceremony will be held at Airspace Indoor Skydiving on April 6, starting at 18:00. Teams and Members of Delegation from every country will be required to take part in a short parade as all the countries and teams are being announced. The ceremony will be held outdoors. Please dress accordingly.

The Opening Ceremony will be followed by the Competitors and Team Leaders Meetings, the draws and the Judges Conference.

## 11. Closing Ceremony

The Closing Ceremony and Award Ceremony will take place at Airspace indoor Skydiving on April 9 starting at 18:00.

The Gala Dinner will be held at the Van der Valk - Hotel Charleroi Airport on the evening of April 9, 2020 starting at 20:00. The Gala Dinner hall has a max capacity of 500 people. With 320 athletes and 60 staff we have a very limited amount of tickets available. If you want to be sure to attend you need to register as either Official Delegation or Accompanying Person. If after this we still have slots available these will be sold at the Airspace Indoor Skydiving Reception during the competition.
