5. Helpful Information and Reminders

Practice Jumps

Skydive Arizona is usually closed on Tuesday and Wednesday until October. For this event, we will be open the Tuesday and Wednesday prior to the event, September 2nd and 3rd respectively. Check in at manifest in the morning and let them know you are practicing for the World Cup.

Course

Carved Speed Course: Right Hand Carve Course

Standard course: Drag Distance 50m and Carved Speed 70m

Accuracy can run from both directions. South is the general direction and could be changed after a completed round due to weather conditions.

See Appendix A for an aerial view of the pond.

Other Matters: National Flag and Anthem

Each delegation must bring its own National Flag (approximately 100 cm x 150 cm) and National Anthem in a downloadable format (CD, MP4) to be used in ceremonies.

Pond

All competitors who want to make practice jumps prior to September 8, 2025 will need to have their pond card completed. (Appendix C)

Judges

The judges will be picked up from Sky Harbor upon arrival. An Airbnb has been rented in Casa Grande and rental cars will be provided for transportation to and from the drop zone. There will be a designated driver for each vehicle.


Equipment

Please note that the US Federal Aviation Administration does not have a reciprocity agreement to allow foreign skydivers to use their equipment as accepted by their own NAC. Unless the equipment has no components with a Technical Standard Order, the parachutes must be packed according to US Federal Aviation Regulations. This means packed by an FAA certified rigger, within 180 days, and with a seal on the reserve. (See Appendix B)


AADs are not required, however, they are highly recommended. Argus AADs cannot be in your container.

All gear and logbook checks will be performed upon arrival.
