To exchange experience and strengthen friendly relations between the sport parachutists of all nations.

To allow participants to share and exchange experience, knowledge and information.

To improve judging methods and practices.

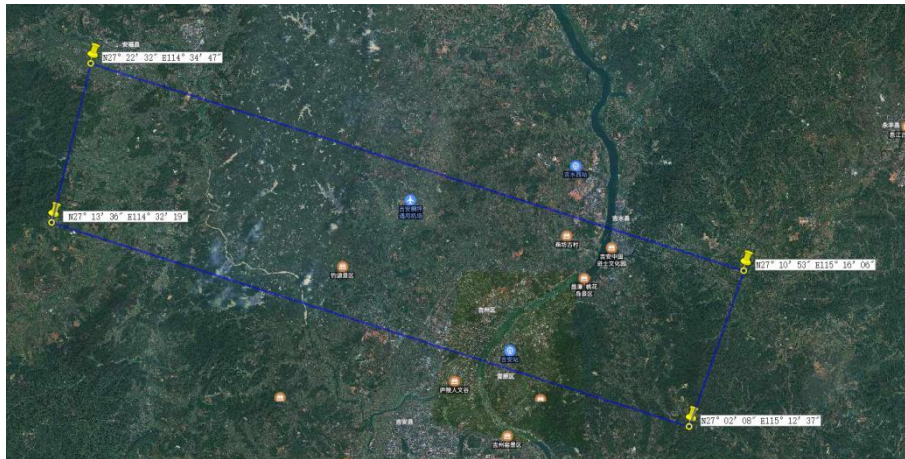

3.2 LOCATION OF THE EVENT

TongPing General Airport, Ji'an, Jiangxi, China.

GPS: Approved by civil and military aviation, the TongPing General Airport is located at E114°54'46" N27°15'15" with a rectangle airspace enclosed by N27°22'32" E114°34'47", N27°13'36" E114°32'19", N27°02'08" E115°12'37", N27°10'53" E115°16'06" with an altitude of 3000 meters. There are no landowner restrictions.

This airport is also the place where 2023 and 2024 National Championships of China were held (as shown in the photos below).

3.3 DETAILS OF ACCESS

The destination airport is Ji'an Jinggangshan Airport (IATA: JGS, ICAO: ZSGS).
Beijing Capital International Airport (IATA: PEK, ICAO: ZBAA) and Beijing

Daxing International Airport (IATA: PKX, ICAO: ZBAD) – (participants can also fly into this airport).

Shanghai's two airports have flights also including Shanghai Pudong International Airport (IATA: PVG, ICAO: ZSPD) and Shanghai Hongqiao International Airport (IATA: SHA, ICAO: ZSSS).

4 TRANSPORTATION

The organizer provides free shuttles from hotel to the airfield. The distance is about a 30 min drive. The detailed schedules of the shuttle bus will be published 1day before the official registration day.

The entry fee covers free shuttle bus from Ji'an Jinggangshan Airport to hotel and hotel to the drop zone, accommodation from official entry to departure, welcome

dinner, closing and awards ceremony and banquet, airfield lunch during competition days, 1 training jump for each competitor in accuracy landing and/or style, official re-jumps.

5.1 ENTRY DATES

Pre - Entry: June 30, 2025

Final - Entry: July 31, 2025

Late Entry: A late entry fee of 1000RMB per person will be applied if received after Aug 14, 2025.

5.2 NUMBER OF TEAMS ALLOWED

As specified in the 2025 FAI competition rules of Style and Accuracy Landing.

5.3 REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

The organizer will accept filled and signed registration forms sent to habdpt@qq.com.

The entry form must be filled and signed by NAC authorised person only (not from an individual competitor).

NOTE: All team managers must have a valid Sporting License, per GS 4.2.3

FAI License

All competitors and Team Leaders/Managers are required to hold a valid sporting license issued by their respective NAC and must be registered in the FAI Sporting License Database prior to submitting their registration.

Note: The names of all competitors and Team Leaders/Managers on the entry form must match EXACTLY as they appear in the FAI Sporting License Database.

5.4 PAYMENT PROCEDURE

The payment of entry fee must accompany the formal entry.

The deadline of the payment is July 31, 2025.

6 FACILITIES

The airfield (including taking off and landing zone) is shown in the picture below.



Tents for all participants will be arranged under the suggestion of the FAI or by the ASFC according to former event experiences.



Other Facilities:

- Outdoor packing zone beside the tents of 400m²;
- Indoor packing zone near the tents of 500m² with parachute store and VIP room;
- WIFI coverage;
- Rigger service;
- Fishing pool, tennis fields, 400m playground and gym complex within 7min walk;
- Media, medical, police and fire emergency areas;
- Water and fast food service;
- Toilets;
- Drop zone screen;
- Official publishing board etc. (i.e. score board)

7 AIRCRAFT DETAILS

Three P750 will be used to serve this event. The aircraft and the exit door detail is shown in the photo below.





The geometry of the exit door of the P750 is 48in-50in wide and 41.3in tall upstream along the fuselage and 39.3in tall at the downstream location. Aircraft are all CCAR-91 and CCAR-136 certified and equipped with seat belts and will be operated in full compliance with China's applicable air regulations.

8 PRE EVENT

At least 1 P750 will provide service for training jumps. The organizer can add one more P750 if necessary, due to demand.

Training jump tickets:

For Style: 300RMB/Person/Jump

For Accuracy Landing: 200RMB/Person/Jump

9 ACCOMMODATION

Ji'an Hotel is the accommodation for this event, its address is: 99 Yanjiang Rd., Ji Zhou, Ji'an, Jiangxi.

The accommodation (from official registration and ending of the event) is covered in the registration fee.

If check in is before the official registration date, the organizer can help to book rooms with a discount price (will be published in Bulletin 2)



10 EQUIPMENT

All participants are required to wear equipment which is in compliance with the FAI Competition rules effective March 1, 2025.

AAD is compulsory.

Reserve repack cycle is **180** days if not set shorter by manufacturer.

All parachutes should be safety checked by the organizer rigger (FAA licensed rigger).

ISC approved judging equipment, measuring and (electronic) scoring system(s) to be used Results publication details (as per ISC requirements).

AIRSHOTS is the official scoring system for this event.

13 MEDICAL/EMERGENCY DETAILS

Emergency Ambulance, Fire Emergency and Police will be set near the drop zone.

All medical and emergency system can provide injury first aid, AED, and antitoxic serum for local snakes (rare to encounter).

Hospital ambulance for severe injury is within 30min drive.

14 INSURANCE DETAILS

All competitors must have full third-party liability insurance (minimum amount of coverage RMB1000000 valid in People's Republic of China and also have insurance to cover medical expenses in the case of injury and repatriation (minimum amount of coverage up to the competitor). In case of any problems please contact the organizers.

Any damage to the hotels etc. is the responsibility of the people involved.

Personal items and equipment are the participants' responsibility

15 VISA INFORMATION

Since People's Republic of China is now visa-exempt to many countries, the ASFC shall remind all athletes that the visa exempt is not for sports events. To ensure the participation of the event and the validity of the insurance in case of any injury, a M visa is recommended. Please browse the People's Republic Embassy website of the athletes' contry for detailed visa application guidelines. The local organizer will sign invitation letters when formal entry form is submitted to support visa application.

16.1 Doping requirements and control:

The Anti-Doping Program may take place at the event. If so - the doping tests are carried out by the official Anti-Doping organization or sample collection provider recognized and approved by World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA). The selection of athletes would be according to the 2021 FAI Anti-Doping Rules, which are based on 2021 WADA Code and are available at:

After receipt of notification until arrival at the point of doping control the selected competitors will be always accompanied by chaperone assigned by the sample collection authority. The selected competitor may be accompanied by a person of their choice (team doctor, coach or head of delegation). If the Organizing Committee does not provide participants with accreditation with the photo on it, the selected athlete will be required to provide a valid passport or identity card at the point of doping control.

Note: Please carefully plan a departure date and time after the competition taking into the account that you may be chosen for the Doping Control.
