Final comments and evaluation of the contest	<ul> <li>The organizers did a good job to organize the World Cup. The, for many years used Airfield is good for flights, good climatic conditions during this time of year, except for Sunday (for details see Alternation of Schedule). Time keeping and judging was objective.</li> <li>Results were prepared on the scoreboard in time. Information Bulletins were prepared on time. The general standard of the flying and competition was good.</li> <li>Comments and recommendations from the Jury: <ol> <li>Better control and management of the allowed motors, as well common storing.</li> <li>Due to the higher number of contestants, the Jury recommends the RSO to have a deputy for better management of the flights.</li> <li>Usage of a PC to manage the scores, to avoid double work in processing the results.</li> <li>Improve competition safety, this is a recommendation to the RSO to take more care when giving launch permission.</li> </ol> </li></ul>
